### **BAND / INSTRUMENTALS**

Kirk Wassmer has recently retired after 35 years of teaching band. The past 23 years he taught at Didsbury High School. Ensembles from DHS consistently received high accolades for their concert and festival performances. Students from Kirk's programs can be found across Western Canada performing and teaching music.

Kirk received his undergraduate degree from the University of Saskatchewan and a Master of Music from the University of Missouri-Columbia. He has conducted regional and provincial honour bands, been on the faculty of summer music schools in BC and Alberta and continues to adjudicate and guest conduct across Western Canada.

IN 2017 Kirk received the David Peterkin Award in recognition of exemplary and consistent contribution to bands and band education from the Mu Alpha chapter of Phi Beta Mu. In 2019 he was presented with the Elkhorn Band Director of the Year award by the Alberta Band Association and in 2022 received the Vondis Miller Legacy Award. In 2024 Kirk received the Keith Mann/National Arts Centre Outstanding Band Director Award from MusicFest – The Nationals and a Prime Minister's Award for Teaching Excellence.

As an advocate for music education and the value of music in young people's lives, Kirk continues to spread the word through workshops and guest conducting engagements. He works to employ a student-centred approach to music education, empowering them to realize the tremendous value that music can bring to their lives.



### **BAND / INSTRUMENTALS**

**Ross McIntyre** has been a conductor/educator within the Westwinds Music Society adult band organization in Calgary since 1992. He retired from The Calgary Board of Education in 2019 after thirty years of teaching both junior and senior high school music and is currently teaching for Mount Royal University, as teacher mentor, guest conductor and trumpet clinician. Ross continues to be active throughout western Canada adjudicating music festivals.

In 1993, Ross received the "Excellence in Teaching Award" from the Alberta government and in 2001 received the "Tommy Banks Award" for his contribution to Jazz education. Ross was honoured in 2006 as one of the University of Calgary's "Top Forty Alumni". In 2013, Ross was awarded by the Canadian Government with the Prime Minister's Award for teaching excellence.

Along with friend and co-producer, Samantha Whelan Kotkas, Ross received funding from the Canadian Space Agency to create and produce "From Blue To Red" - a hard cover children's book and interactive online e-book. The book was written and illustrated by Lord Beaverbrook High School students who were inspired by several professional mentors from across Canada. "From Blue To Red" features the narration of Jazz legend, Diana Krall and three Canadian astronauts: Dr. Robert Thirsk, Julie Payette and David Saint- Jacques. "From Blue to Red" was chosen as the recipient of the 2013 Award for "Best Children's and Young Adult Book of the Year" among Alberta Publishers.



## JUNIOR PIANO

Canadian pianist, organist, and cellist **Ivea Mark** holds graduate degrees in Piano Pedagogy and Music Research from the University of Ottawa and is an RCM Advanced Specialist in Piano, Theory, Harmony, and History. A dedicated teacher, she has guided students to provincial and national awards.

Ivea obtained a Bachelor of Arts from Ambrose University and a Masters of Arts in Music from the University of Ottawa. While attending University, she was also juggling a thriving studio and a family. She learned to be disciplined in the use of her time and graduated *cum sum laude* from the first, and a perfect GPA from the latter. "I know commitment and passion, and am always looking to imbue excellence into all I teach".

Ivea is also an active collaborative performer, appearing regularly as a pianist, cellist, organist, choir accompanist, and orchestral rehearsal pianist.



## SENIOR PIANO

**Annette Poirier-Bradley** completed her extensive music study while residing in Calgary, Alberta. She completed the Associate of the Royal Conservatory of Toronto (ARCT) and the Associate of the Mount Royal Conservatory of Calgary (AMRC), both in Piano Performance, and earned her Bachelor of Education majoring in Elementary Music at the University of Calgary.. She later completed various post-graduate studies including her Master of Education majoring in music from the University of Alberta.

Annette's musical experience ranges from teaching private piano lessons for 44 years, directing award winning choirs and bands, to teaching classroom music, junior high band and high school choral music in both schools and at the university level. She has experience being a professional accompanist for solo and ensemble groups, for ballet classes and musical theatre as well as being a guest pianist and flautist on occasion.

Annette's piano students have done exceptionally well over the years and have earned various awards and scholarships. She has just celebrated 41 years of membership and has held various positions with the Alberta Registered Music Teacher's Association (ARMTA) and is currently the president of the association. She was on faculty at Red Deer College for 11 years in the music department. and taught mostly music in various school systems for 35 years.

Annette continues to enjoy teaching piano and theory lessons in her private studio and has been examining with the Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) since 2019. She directs the Red Deer Children's Choir, the Ross Street Singers and adjudicates piano classes in music festivals. She has various hobbies and enjoys spending time with her family, her grandchildren, her dog and her husband of 36 years .



## CHORUS

Professor Emeritus (from Concordia University of Edmonton), **Dr. Joy Berg** is delighted to now be living in the Camrose community. Joy received her piano performance degree (U of Sask), education teaching certificate (U. of Alberta), and choral conducting degrees (U. of Alberta, U of Iowa doctorate), as well as a worship doctorate (Robert Webber Institute). Joy has shared her love of the human voice through the doing (Joy sang for 16 years as an Alto with *Procoro Canada*, Edmonton's professional choir), through the teaching (in her private studio), and through choral work (with her role as professor, with many guest conducting opportunities, with many adjudicating contracts, as well as with

international choral tours).

Joy has been a church musician from full-time to part-time in both Lutheran and Anglican denominations and has taught university courses as well as led many workshops on various aspects of this role in the Church. Joy has done extensive research on Canadian Hymnody (including being the Canadian representative to the Lutheran World Federation convention music for the 2003 convention in Winnipeg), and she is the curator for the Cypress Publishing church choir series, *Songs for the Sanctuary*.

Dr. Berg holds a Doctorate of Music degree in Choral Conducting as well as a Doctorate of Worship Arts – and is currently finishing off her diaconal minister certification within the ELCiC denomination. Joy enjoys her continuing role in conducting The Kings Community and Alumni Chorus throughout the year, teaching piano and voice, and is active as a church musician at Messiah Lutheran Church in Camrose.

## VOCALS / MUSICAL THEATRE



Dr. Danica Hoffart is a singer, conductor, musical director, educator, and adjudicator. She currently directs the Ross Street Singers, teaches privately, and is a vocalist with the Central Alberta Chamber Orchestra. For over two decades, Danica taught post-secondary Music and Theatre including private voice lessons, choir, singing for the stage, music history, and ear training.

She has performed with Kompany! Dance and has been a soprano soloist with the Red Deer Symphony Orchestra. Select musical directing credits include *South Pacific*, *Footloose*, *Cabaret*, *The Sound of Music*, and *The Wizard of Oz*.

Danica holds a Bachelor of Music and a Master of Arts in Music from the University of Alberta, and a PhD in Music from the University of Calgary. Her doctoral research examined best practices in leadership and the empowerment of individuals through participation in choir.



## STRINGS

**Catherine Butcher** is a graduate of the University of Calgary, where she obtained her Bachelor of Music in Violin Performance in 2022. She also completed the Mount Royal University Advanced Performance Program while studying in Calgary with William van der Sloot and Edmond Agopian. During this time, she traveled to Europe as a member of the Calgary Youth Orchestra in 2018, where the ensemble performed in Austria, Hungary and Prague.

Growing up in Lacombe, Ms. Butcher enjoyed sharing fiddle and classical music with her siblings, who are also musicians. Together they played regularly at her local church while she received her early grounding in technique and performance through her first violin teacher, Louise Stuppard.

In 2012, she won the first prize of five hundred dollars at the Lacombe's Got Talent Show in her hometown. She also volunteered locally at Michener Extencicare senior's home in Red Deer and played concertmaster for Naomi Delafield's Rosedale Valley Strings Orchestra as a teenager. These experiences shaped her pursuit of performance and contributed to a strong community-based approach to music, which led her to complete a Masters in Violin Performance at McGill University in 2025.

Currently, Ms. Butcher is serving as a section violinist and music librarian for the Red Deer Symphony Orchestra. She also teaches privately in Lacombe and Red Deer, where she enjoys sharing her love of performance and community with her students.
